### *Synopsis*

A nervous camcorder follows a three day *dérive* through the recent history of the Balkans.

Starting in the church of Medugorje, the trip passes by Sarajevo, with its mosques and its cemeteries, makes a detour in the open tombs of Srebrenica, and finishes in Belgrade with a folk festival. The film preserves images of the present that bring us back to the recent past in a continuous *devenir*.

A visual experience in four episodes on religion, war and nationalism. Can a reflexive gaze reopen the scars left by the war?
